



Québec's Wallyball Cup (2nd edition) – April 25th-26th, 2020



BASIC RULES

The Wallyball Information Network (WIN!) rules will be applied in this tournament, with the exception of a few house rules. This tournament will be completely self-refereed so in doubt on a fault, the point will be replayed. Here are the main differences between the WIN! 2012 rulebook and Québec's house rules.

Section	Wallyball rulebook 2012	House rules Québec 2020
6.02 LEGAL SERVICE	The ball must not contact the net or net hardware.	The ball may contact the net or net hardware, as long as it passes over.
7.13 THE BALL PASSING THROUGH THE NET OPENING	Any ball passing through the net opening on the first or second hit of a volley will be replayed. A ball passing through the net opening on the third hit or on the serve will result in a side-out.	Any ball passing through the net opening will result in a side-out.
8.14 CLIMBING THE WALLS	Players may not climb the wall(s) to make a play on the ball.	Players may climb the wall(s) to make a play on the ball, except on services.
9.04 DURING PLAY FAULTS	There is a fault when the ball contacts a player below the waist.	The ball can be played with any parts of the body with one exception. Feet cannot be used to hit the ball (and cross) over the net.

THE ESSENTIALS

What's NOT allowed?	What's allowed?
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Receiving the service with an open hand finger pass; ▪ Any contact with the net; ▪ Boy blocking a girl or simulation; ▪ Crossing entirely over the centerline with a foot; ▪ Throwing, scooping, lifting, pushing or carrying the ball with one or two hands or arms; ▪ Powertips. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Ball touching the net and passing over on services; ▪ Climbing, except for the reception of services; ▪ Any parts of the body; ▪ Dinking. Using the knuckles of the hand, the closed fist, the back of the hand and using the cobra shot; ▪ Multiple body contacts with the ball on first hit or serve, as long as it's done simultaneously;
